Job Description

The North Campus Worship Director at Shadow Hills Church is responsible for leading, organizing, and structuring weekly worship gatherings at the North Campus. This role exists to cultivate Spirit-led and excellence-driven worship that serves the vision and mission of Shadow Hills Church while meeting the unique needs of the North Campus congregation.

General Responsibilities

The position of North Campus Worship Director is part-time.

Key Tasks and Responsibilities

Worship Coordinating

1. Responsible for leading and directing the worship of the North Campus weekly.
2. Lead, equip, and empower volunteer worship leaders and musicians.
3. Recruit new vocalists and musicians to join the team.
4. Organize and structure the Planning Center order of service for each weekend.
5. Schedule vocal and band members weekly.
6. Collaborate with the Summerlin Campus worship team.
7. Attend all campus worship planning meetings weekly.
8. Care for the spiritual well-being of the worship team.

Minimum Requirements

Spiritual and Personal

- Maintain a life of personal and spiritual integrity and accountability.
- Refrain from any social or private behavior considered or interpreted as unbecoming of a devoted follower of Christ. This includes personal social media presence.

Professional

- Minimum of two (2) years of worship experience in a church setting.
- Leadership ability, including conflict management.
- Excellent communication in small and large group settings.
- Passion for Serving the Church.
